LiveHealth Online:

We recently met with representatives from Anthem (our health insurance TPA) and CBIZ (our health insurance consultant). I wanted to provide an update on our LiveHealth Online utilization.

As we've discussed in the past, the LiveHealth Online tool can be a great benefit and offers significant convenience and cost savings for employees. While the average cost for use of the tool is \$49, the normal office **co-pay for visits of \$10 applies**. LiveHealth Online provides major cost savings compared to Urgent Care and ER visits.

Facilities Finance Committee

The **Facilities Finance Committee** met on May 22nd to further discuss various financing options for recommendation to the Board of Education for placement on the November 2018 ballot.

The Finance Committee discussed the overall costs associated with property tax, earned income tax, and a property/earned income combination tax.

After review and discussion, the Finance Committee members in attendance came to a consensus regarding the best option for our community. While the ultimate decision will be up to the Board of Education, the Facilities Finance Committee will be making its recommendation to the Board of Education at its **June 27th Board meeting**.
