

PICK UP PROCEDURES

The system of student pick-up at the 3:15 pm dismissal bell is intended to reduce congestion and provide security inside and outside of the building. An organized and supervised approach to the 3:15 pm student pick-up will insure transfer of responsibility from school to parent without incident. The following information describes student pick- up procedures. Parent and student cooperation is sincerely appreciated.

Duty teachers and car students will exit the kindergarten/second grade hall at the dismissal bell. Duty teachers will supervise students entering the proper vehicle. The line of waiting vehicles will extend down the west parking lot. As vehicles are loaded and leaving the sidewalk pick-up area, other vehicles will pull up to the sidewalk where children and duty teachers are waiting.

If parents decide to park and pick-up their child, please park at the large parking lot and come into the front of the building. Parents must enter the building before 3:15 pm and wait in the foyer. Please, do not walk up to the pick-up line and pickup your child. We want to ensure the safety of all of our children and our parents.

2014-15 Kindergarten Registration

Lexington Local Schools will be holding Kindergarten registration on Thursday, Feb. 20 from 9am-3pm and 4:30pm-7pm and Feb. 25 from 4:30pm-7pm at Central and Western Elementary Schools.

To be eligible for kindergarten your child must be 5 years old on or before August 1 st. The following documentation is required for kindergarten registration: birth certificate, SS card, immunization record, legal paperwork, proof of residence, and driver's license.

Parents can sign-up for a kindergarten screening date and time during registration.
