Lexington Schools **RENEWAL** Levy

Election day is Tuesday, March 15, 2016

- The ballot issue is a **RENEWAL levy** of a current emergency operation levy originally passed in 2011. This is a different emergency renewal levy from the one renewed in 2014.
- This is ZERO tax increase renewal levy. It will NOT increase your taxes.
- This operating levy represents **13%** of the district's general fund budget or 2.7 million dollars.
- The levy dollars are used for the costs associated with the day to day operations of the district.
- The RENEWAL levy will be collected for a period of ten
 (10) years instead of the five years originally approved.
- These funds are critical to continuing the current staffing and programs offered students.
- Losing 13% of the budget would be devastating to our district and the opportunities we provide our students.
- Our district has reduced costs and eliminated over \$3 million in planned expenses over the past 10 years.
- We have made tremendous efforts to keep costs low and enact cost savings and still provide our students with the best educational and co-curricular opportunities possible.
