2020-2021 Kindergarten Registration

Lexington Local Schools will be holding Kindergarten registration on Thursday, March 5 from 9:30am-3pm and 4:30pm-7pm and March 12 from 4:30pm-7pm at Central and Western Elementary Schools.

To be eligible for kindergarten your child must be 5 years old on or before August 1, 2020. The following documentation is required for kindergarten registration: birth certificate, Social Security card, immunization record, legal paperwork, proof of residence, and driver's license.

Parents can sign up for a kindergarten screening date & time during registration. Screening is scheduled for April 29-May 1.
