CCP Application Process (Fall 2024):

In order for a student to be eligible to take classes through CCP in the 24-25 school year, you will need to complete the following steps by the dates provided.

- Attend a CCP informational meeting to review the CCP process, Jan 24 at 7pm. The presentation from this meeting will be posted on the high school's website under Student Resources>College Credit Plus.
- Complete the Intent to Participate form; submit the google form by Apr 1. The link to this form can be found by scanning the QR code (with your phone's camera) to the right or in the presentation.



- Testing may be required for admission or for placement into certain courses at each college.
 - □ Colleges may accept the ACCUPLACER
 - □ Each college/university has different requirements.
 - □ If you have already taken the ACT, colleges will accept your test scores from your transcript.
- Complete the online application for CCP at the college you would like to attend (students taking classes at Lexington High School for college credit will need to apply to BGSU and/or Ashland University).
- □ Request your transcript to be submitted **BEFORE** the deadline (at least a week).

 - □ NCSC fall deadline is July 1. <u>www.ncstatecollege.edu/ccp</u>

- Submit any High School Information forms that may be required by your college to your counselor to be completed, if required (OSU).
- Students taking CCP courses at LHS will schedule their classes with the counselor.
- □ Students *taking classes on a college/university campus* will complete an orientation, and schedule a meeting with an advisor at the college. The college advisor will schedule the classes that will be taken on their campus (or online).
