

CCP Application Process (Fall 2022):

In order for your student to be eligible to take classes through CCP, you will need to complete the following steps by the dates provided.

- ❑ Attend a CCP informational meeting to review the CCP process. The PowerPoint from this meeting will be posted on the high school's website under Student Resources>College Credit Plus.

- ❑ Complete the *Intent to Participate* form; submit the google form **by Apr 1**. The link to this form can be found by scanning the QR code (with your phone's camera) to the right or in the PowerPoint presentation.



- ❑ Register to take the ACT/SAT and have test scores sent to colleges where you are seeking admission into their CCP program (register to test early, so you don't miss your college deadline).

- ❑ *Testing requirements may change based on ODE CCP pending changes. Check your college's website for updated information.*

- ❑ Colleges may accept the ACCUPLACER

- ❑ Each college/university may have different exam requirements

- ❑ If you have already taken the ACT, colleges will accept your test scores from your transcript.

- ❑ Complete the online application for CCP at the college you would like to attend (students taking classes at Lexington High School for college credit will need to apply to BGSU or Ashland University).

- ❑ Submit any High School Information forms that may be required by your college to your counselor to be completed.

- ❑ Request your transcript to be submitted **BEFORE** the deadline (at least a week).

- ❑ BGSU fall deadline is **May15**. <https://www.bgsu.edu/college-credit-plus/apply-now.html>

- ❑ OSU fall deadline is **May 1**. go.osu.edu/mansccp
