COVID-19 exposure within a classroom or during required school transportation	COVID-19 exposure in an area other than the classroom or during required school transportation:
<ul> <li>All safety precautions were being followed:         <ul> <li>Examples-Mask compliance at all times (nose &amp; mouth covered), social distancing, cleaning, disinfecting, symptom management, etc.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Cafeteria, gym class, recess, music class, etc.</li> <li>All safety precautions are unable to be followed:</li> <li>Examples-Eating, masks not worn at all times, social distancing unable to be maintained, etc.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Students may continue to attend in-person school.</li> </ul>	• Students should not attend in-person school.
<ul> <li>Students may participate in extracurricular activities.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Students must continue to self-monitor symptoms.</li> </ul>
• Students must continue to self-monitor symptoms for 14 days.	<ul> <li>Students must follow quarantine protocols outside of school.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Students may not participate in extracurricular activities during the quarantine period.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Your child may end quarantine and return to normal activities:</li> <li>After 10 days without testing</li> <li>OR after 7 days with a negative result for a test that happened on the fifth day or later</li> </ul>

## **Ohio Public Health Advisory System Reminders**

Purple	If Richland County is Purple or Red, students with COVID-19 symptoms will be sent home from school. Students may return to in-person school in 10 days, or with an alternative diagnosis from a doctor.	
Red		
Orange	If Richland County is Orange or Yellow, students with COVID-19 symptoms will be sent home from school. Students may return to in-person school after 24 hours symptom free.	
Yellow		
**Students should monitor and self-check symptoms daily. Students should not attend in-person school with any COVID-19 symptoms.**
