**Eligibility:**

1. Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen.
2. Applicant must currently be a **high school senior** who will attend OSU-M, NCSC, or the Dwight Schar College of Nursing OR
3. Any student **currently enrolled** in one of the above for the current academic year.
4. The student must have a 3.0 or above grade point average (on a 4.0 scale or equivalent).

All applicants must be citizens of the United States and legal residents of the state of Ohio and must attend an accredited college or university in the United States. Awards are placed on deposit with the college or university, and any unused portion shall be returned to OSDAR. No affiliation or relationship with DAR is necessary; however, all applicants must obtain a letter of sponsorship from their local DAR Chapter. Only applications completed correctly and submitted in one package will be considered. No records are returned. Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, religion, sex, national origin or disability. Only winners will be notified.

**Instructions:** The application package must be completed and arranged in order described below. All original transcripts, letters of recommendation and other required documents must be received by the state chairman by the deadline in a single package as described. If your school requires that any documents be sent to another party, the applicant must arrange with the sponsoring chapter to receive the documents and forward them with the application in one package, opened and stapled, to the state chairman before the deadline. Do not submit a personal photograph.

2. Scholarship Application (this page).
3. Official transcript of high school grades which also indicates class rank/size and test scores unless home schooled. Home schooled students include grade transcripts for grade 9 through the current year and documented test scores.
4. Financial Need Form.
5. The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) Student Aid Report (SAR). By submitting the FAFSA electronically at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov), you should receive the SAR in seven to ten days.
6. An essay of 500 words or less on "Eternal Vigilance is the Price of Liberty."
7. A statement of 200 words or less describing what makes you an outstanding candidate for the scholarship.
8. List on one side of 8½" by 11" paper: extra-curricular activities, honors received, scholastic achievements, or other significant accomplishments, maximum one page, one side.
9. Dated and signed letters of recommendation from at least three but not more than five persons in authority from the high school or college the applicant now attends, who are familiar with the applicant's work. Letter may cover the applicant's ability, work habits, integrity, character, potential, and activities. Each letter must include the title, address and telephone number of the person giving the recommendation for possible contact or verification.
10. Proof of United States Citizenship: photocopy of birth certificate or naturalization papers. Note: temporarily cover the photograph if photocopying naturalization papers.
11. Applicant package should be stapled in the top, left hand corner. The number of papers in the package must not exceed sixteen (16)
12. Mail completed application on or before February 1 to the State Chairman listed at the top of this page.

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## **DAR SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE STATE CHAIRMAN AND CHAPTER INFORMATION SHEET**

Each scholarship is funded by an endowment of funds left in a will or an outright gift by an individual or family which states certain conditions. **NSDAR honors those wishes and is required to do so.** The amount of the award for each scholarship is based on the actual income from the fund and takes into consideration the amount of money that is already committed. Since some of the scholarships are for four years, the funds already committed must be distributed first.

While chapter sponsorship is no longer required, a chapter or state chairman may work with the student to put the information together to send to the national chairman. State chairmen and chapters should follow the instructions carefully on the application form and the DAR Scholarship Committee Fact Sheet to determine if the applicant meets the criteria of the scholarship for which she/he is applying. These forms are found on the DAR website. **The DAR Scholarship Committee does not process DAR Good Citizens, American Indian, DAR School or state scholarships.**

Please note the following:

- The **Lillian and Arthur Dunn Scholarship** requires that the DAR national number of the **mother**, who is a current dues-paying member, be on the application.
- The **Enid Griswold Memorial Scholarship** is awarded to a **junior or senior** enrolled in an accredited college or university.
- The **Nursing School Scholarships** require the student to have been **accepted or enrolled** in an accredited school of nursing. A **letter of acceptance** must be included or the **transcript stating the applicant is enrolled** in the nursing program must be included with the application.
- The medical school scholarships require that the student has been accepted or is pursuing an approved course of study to become a **medical doctor** (no pre-med).
- DAR Scholarship applications are to be sent to the national chairman **postmarked no later than February 15**. (Do not send separate mailings for the same application). **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
- Students are notified of their scholarships by the national chairman and are awarded only after the national Executive Committee has approved all students selected. **Only winners will be notified.** Strictly follow these guidelines in order to avoid any misunderstanding.
- Multiyear scholarship winners must send their transcripts to the Office of the Reporter General-Committee Services, NSDAR, 1776 D Street NW, Washington, DC 20006-5303 **by July 1 of each year.**
- If a state chairman or a chapter assists the applicant and mails the application, the sealed references or transcripts may be opened to put them in order before mailing. Please do not do this while the student is present.

The DAR Scholarship Committee invites state chairmen and chapters to aid applicants with the application process. Please follow instructions carefully. Applicants spend a great deal of time, effort and resources toward completing the applications correctly as they pursue their quest for further education. We are thrilled to consider all applications for this opportunity the DAR provides through our generous scholarship program.

The application package must be stapled or paper clipped in the top left hand corner not to exceed 15 pages. A separate application must be submitted for each scholarship. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

# National DAR General Scholarship Information

## Application Requirements

All applicants must be citizens of the United States and must attend or plan to attend an accredited college or university in the United States. DAR chapter sponsorship is not required; however, a chapter or state chairman may work with the applicant to put the information together to send to the DAR Scholarship Committee.

To apply, go to [www.dar.org](http://www.dar.org) and click to download the necessary application forms (samples included in this packet):

Mail completed DAR Scholarship Committee application forms to the address listed under each scholarship.

### Important:

- All applications must be postmarked by February 10.
- This address is only correct during the 2013-2016 DAR Administration.
- This application form is **not** to be used for the American Indian Scholarships and DAR Good Citizen Scholarships - those applications are sent to different addresses for processing.

Only applications completed correctly and submitted in one package will be considered. Incorrect applications or applications mailed to the incorrect address will be discarded. No records are returned. **Do not submit a personal photo.** If your records feature a photo, it must be fully covered. Only winners are notified by the National DAR Scholarship Chairman following the approval of a ruling by the Executive Committee of NSDAR.

Consecutive-year renewals do not require additional Executive Committee rulings, but do require that an official transcript be sent from the school to the Office of the Reporter General, NSDAR, 1776 D Street NW, Washington DC 20006-5303 by July 1st of each year. Students are only eligible for one scholarship from the National Society.

Awards are placed on deposit with the college or university; any unused portion shall be returned to the National Society. Awards are based on academic merit, commitment to the field of study and financial need. No affiliation with DAR is necessary unless specified. All applications must be received on or before the deadline indicated for each specific scholarship.

**Note:** The DAR Scholarship Committee does not process DAR Good Citizens, American Indian, DAR School or state scholarships.

## General Scholarships

### Richard and Elizabeth Dean Scholarship

The Richard and Elizabeth Dean Scholarship is a preferred amount of \$5,000 each year for up to four consecutive years to graduating high school students. The selection process shall be based on academic merit with an initial minimum GPA of 4.0. Renewal is conditional upon maintenance of a GPA of 3.25.

This scholarship is renewable only after review and approval of the annual official transcript. Renewal transcript must be submitted to the Office of the Reporter General by July 1 of the year of renewal or the scholarship is forfeited.

## Political Science, History, Government and Economics Scholarships

A separate application must be submitted for each scholarship in this group. The following scholarships are available in the areas of political science, history, government, and economics:
