I am excited to tell you about the remarkable opportunity for some students who meet several specific criteria to have their college tuition covered within the College of Business and Innovation (COBI) at The University of Toledo, thanks to the tremendous and sincere generosity of a COBI alum. The Kinsey Determination Scholarship was established in 2000 at The University of Toledo with a \$1 million donation from Edward P. - He must be a male with a single mother and have lived the majority of his life without the presence of a father or male guardian
- He must have a current FAFSA on file with the UT Office of Financial Aid, as the award is also based on financial need
- He must have a strong desire for lifelong achievement, a demonstrated work ethic, personal integrity, a strong desire to help others and give back to the community, and a strong belief in God.
- Recipients must obtain full-time employment in the summer (unless attending school full time)
- Recipients must send at least one letter each year to the donor describing his academic performance and campus activities, and agree to meet with the donor at graduation to discuss providing assistance to others in similar situations.
