



## The Ohio State University Alumni Scholars Program

Information for the student

The Ohio State University Alumni Scholars Program (ASP) is intended to provide recognition and financial assistance to outstanding incoming OSU freshmen. The Richland County Alumni Club of the Ohio State University, in coordination with the OSU offices of Admissions and Student Financial Aid, both funds and administers ASP scholarships for students residing in Richland County.

The OSU Richland County Alumni Club will offer four ASP Scholarships in 2016:

- Two named Jeff Molyet scholarships to the Ohio State University-Mansfield. One of these will be a one-year, **full-tuition** scholarship to OSU-Mansfield. The other will be a one-year, **half-tuition** scholarship to OSU-Mansfield.
- Two **\$1000** ASP scholarships to any campus of The Ohio State University.

To be eligible you must be a graduating senior and a resident of Richland County. These awards are based solely on merit. The selection criteria are:

- Rank in high school graduating class (*top 15% minimum*)
- ACT and/or SAT scores (*most past winners have had ACT composites of 25 or higher.*)
- Demonstrated involvement in school and community activities
- Work ethic and positive attitude toward studies at The Ohio State University

You should complete Part I of the *OSU Alumni Scholars Program Application*, and then have your principal, counsellor or teacher complete Part II, which recommends you for the scholarship. It is very important that this person attach a copy of your **transcript** to the application. The alumni club scholarship chairperson must receive the complete application, with transcript, no later than **January 30th**. You must complete your part of the application in time for your guidance counsellor to meet this deadline.

You must complete an **Undergraduate Admission Application** to OSU in order to be considered for this scholarship. Application forms are available from your high school guidance counselor or you may apply on-line at [www.apply.osu.edu](http://www.apply.osu.edu)

Award posting from the Office of Student Financial Aid will be visible on recipients' Buckeye Link account beginning in March. The postings include all aid a student is eligible to receive. If you are a recipient of an ASP award, it will be listed as "Richland County Ohio State University Alumni Club The Ohio State University at Mansfield Scholarship Endowment Fund".
