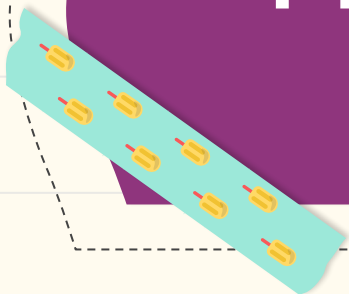
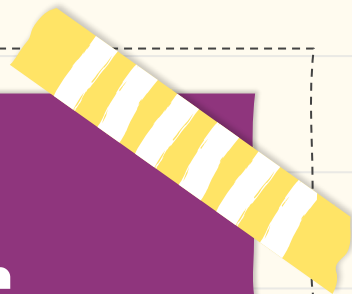
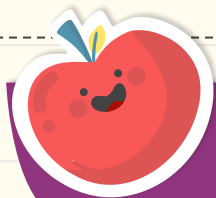
Early Learning Assessment-assessment done through teacher observation; reported in fall and spring

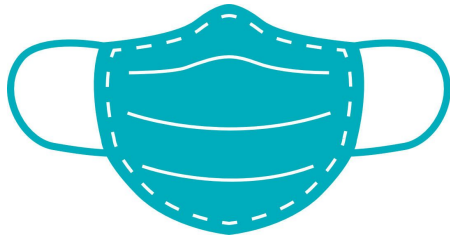
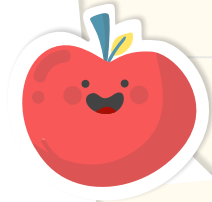

AM Preschool begins at **8:55**- You will escort your child to the classroom for drop off, beginning at **8:45**. After the first day of school, we ask that you to say goodbye at the door, in the hallway, so your child can be independent in their arrival routines.

AM Dismissal will begin at **11:30**- You will pull up to Western's front doors when it is clear of buses, -please remain in your car until staff brings your child to your vehicle.

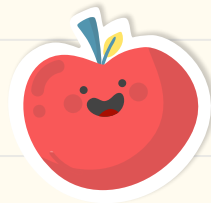
