



COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY & CAREER TECHNICAL SCHOLARSHIPS FOR LEXINGTON HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES

Twenty-two years ago a group of four Lexington High School graduates created a scholarship fund to assist Lexington graduates with the rising costs of college. This group undertook the task of contacting other Lexington graduates, Lexington based businesses and local industries with Lexington ties to donate to this fund.

Their efforts raised a total of \$13,600 from 16 donors!

The Lexington High School Alumni Scholarship Fund was established at the Richland County Foundation.

In that first year (2004), a \$1,000 scholarship was awarded from the Lexington High School Alumni.

In 2025, 11 college scholarships in the amount of \$25,000 were awarded. Since those initial years, the fund with the Richland County Foundation has grown! The generous donations of Lexington High School Alumni continue to allow this fund to increase.

Scholarships are awarded to graduates (post & present) entering college and career technical areas.



GIRLS' & BOYS' CROSS COUNTRY


Coach Denise Benson is beginning her 27th season as head coach of both the Lexington Girls and Boys Cross Country teams. LEXCC is focused, excited




BOYS' SOCCER
