PBIS is a broad range of systematic and individualized strategies for achieving important social and learning outcomes in schools while preventing problem behavior.

School communities identify 3-5 school-wide overarching behavioral expectations.

#### Comprehensive Instruction

Systematic, explicit instruction, practice and feedback on the expected behaviors are provided in each school setting.

#### Supportive Structure

Teams focus on developing a setting in schools that provide effective academic and behavioral multi-tiered system of supports (MTSS) for all students.

# Acknowledging and Correcting Behavior Systems

Consistency in acknowledging expected behaviors and correcting behavior errors is provided through:

- Active supervision
- Proactive scheduling
- · Incentives and reinforcement
- Logical consequences and clear office referral procedures

### PBIS AT LEXINGTON:

- PBIS teams have been established in each building and meet
