Graduation Ceremony

- If there is inclement weather, then graduation will be moved inside to the high school gymnasium

 - You only need the tickets if it is raining and we are forced inside

- Students are required to wear issued cap and gowns as well as school issued medals and/or chords
 - Personal, religious, political or other non school issued articles are not to be worn during the ceremony.
