Anthem Rx

As a reminder, beginning July 1, 2019, Anthem will launch IngenioRx, its new pharmacy benefit manager which will replace ExpressScripts for our pharmacy. There are no changes to our prescription coverage, and Anthem has indicated that this transition will be made with as little disruption as possible and that most of the changes will occur behind the scenes. However, Anthem will be sending information to each of us as members detailing the transition and any steps we need to take for our personal prescription needs.

I figured it may be a good time as we head into the summer months to re-visit our LiveHealth Online option. When it comes to health provider options available to us, as we've discussed in the past, the LiveHealth Online tool can be a great benefit and offers significant convenience and cost savings for employees. While the average cost for use of the tool is \$49, the normal office **co-pay for visits of \$10 applies**. You will need to ensure that your updated insurance card information is entered. LiveHealth Online provides major cost savings compared to Urgent Care and ER visits.

Facilities Update

On Monday, May 20th, after receiving approval from the OFCC at the end of April, the Controlling Board approved our participation in the OFCC Expedited Local Partnership (ELPP). This will allow us to move forward with our local share for the design and construction of the 7-12 building. The overall timeline for planning and design is estimated at approximately 12 months and the construction timeline is estimated at approximately 2 to 2.5 years based on the square footage of the building. The first stage, beginning this summer, will be design work on the relocation of our baseball, softball, and soccer venues. The goal is to have those venues relocated as soon as possible to allow for playing surfaces to mature to allow for the venues to be ready for play by the time we are ready to begin construction on the new 7-12 building.

Additionally, we have been preparing to meet with ratings analysts from Moody's to establish our **bond** rating for the sale of our bonds. We will meet with analysts from Moody's on **June 11**th and our bond rating, along with the interest rate market, will determine the overall interest rate of our bonds.
